FISHING IN MEĐIMURJE

The smallest, northernmost, most populated, youngest, most orderly, and for us the most beautiful country of our homeland. It is bordered by the river Mura in the north, the river Drava in the south, and lined with streams, brooks and numerous gravel pits in the middle. In short, a God-given fishing destination.

The rich waters on approximately 2,200 hectares have resulted in a rich variety of fish species – a total of 66. The Cyprinidae are the most prevalent, with 24 species, and the diversity is complemented with salmonid fish species such as the brown trout and California trout, including a few graylings in the drainage canals of the Dubrava hydroelectric power plant, and, in smaller numbers, in the drainage canals of the Čakovec hydroelectric power plant.

FISHING LICENSE PRICES

- annual license for Croatian and foreign nationals aged 19 years and above: 400.00 HRK +100.00 HRK for the membership card (valid for 30 trout fishing days)
- Daily license: 60,00 HRK (valid for all waters except for the drainage canal)
- Daily license for the drainage canal from Prelog to Sveta Marija for trout 150,00 HRK
- Annual license for Croatian and foreign nationals aged 15 years and above 200,00 HRK
- Annual license for Croatian and foreign nationals aged 15 to 18 years 200,00 HRK
- A membership card purchased at any club at the price of 50.00 HRK is valid as a fishing license for Croatian and foreign nationals aged up to 15 years

HUNTING IN MEĐIMURJE

Hunting in Međimurje has a long tradition. Experts with high moral principles who work on the development of hunting grounds, respect for the food chain and harvesting contribute to an increasing number of supporters of hunting today.

Deer is the most prevalent in the large game category on the hunting grounds. Gravel extraction in the catchment of the Drava has created a series of gravel pits suitable for wild duck and wild geese hunting. The hunting grounds in the plain of the county are rich with small game (pheasant, Eurasian woodcock, partridge, common quail, and hare).

The hunting clubs are members of the Hunting Association of Međimurje County. As lessee of the common hunting grounds, they are responsible for hunting and hunting tourism. The hunting clubs ensure an excellent organisation of hunting, and all of the accompanying logistics.
